Add SI 1.91.

SKUD 18 class rules C1.1(b) and (c) are deleted.

Note: This rule was not changed in the class rules when the RRS were updated for 2013. As a consequence, the class rule unintentionally deletes the new RRS 42.3(c).

This class rule is not needed as the matter is addressed in RRS 42.39e), which reads:


(e) if a batten is inverted, the boat's crew may pump the sail until the batten is no longer inverted. This action is not permitted if it clearly propels the boat.
