NOTICE of RACE

The **Delta Lloyd Regatta 2016 for Moth class** will be held at Medemblik, the Netherlands from Thursday 26th until Saturday May 28th 2016.

The Organizing Authority is the Royal Netherlands Watersport Association, the Royal Yacht Club Hollandia and Trefpunt-PRISM

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The SI will specify amendments of rules including rules of RRS Part 2 as approved by IMCA and ISAF.
- 1.3 No National Authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display bow numbers and advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.
- 2.2 Competitors ranked first, second and third in the series at the beginning of each day, may be required to display a yellow, blue or red sticker, respectively, on each side of her mainsail. The stickers will be provided by the Organising Authority.

3 ENTRY REGULATIONS AND ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 Competitors and coaches shall enter by completing the on-line entry form on the event website <http://www.deltalloydregatta.org> and paying the required fees. Entry in the event is not final until payment and registration is completed.
- 3.2 ISAF Eligibility shall apply. Each athlete shall be registered as an ISAF Sailor on the ISAF website: www.sailing.org/isafsailor
- 3.3 Competitors under 18 years of age shall present a signed and completed parent (or guardian) consent and declaration form at registration. The forms are available for download on the event website <http://www.deltalloydregatta.org>.
- 3.4 The Organising Authority may cancel an event if a minimum number of entries has not been received by midnight (local time), Monday May 2, 2016. Competitors will be notified of cancelled events by email and posting on the event website. The entry fees for cancelled events will be refunded.

4 FEES

The Entry Fee is as follows: Euro 150,- early entry fee, Euro 170,- late entry fee. Fees are stated in EURO and include any local taxes. Entries including payment must be received no later than Monday May 2, 2016 to qualify for the early entry fee.

4.1 The Entry Fee for coaches and other team personnel is Euro 30,- , Euro 40,- late entry fee.

4.2 If an entry is cancelled by the competitor, the competitor is obliged to pay as follows:

Cancellation Date (by midnight, local time)	Percentage of Entry Fee to be paid
On or before Monday May 2 2016	0%
On or before Monday May 16 2016	50%
After Monday May 16 2016	100%

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration for competitors, coaches and team leaders is scheduled:

Wednesday May 25, 1300-1800 at the International Sailing Center Medemblik.

5.2 The first daily briefing for sailors, coaches and team leaders is scheduled for 2000 from Wednesday May 25 at Regatta Center Medemblik.

5.3 The opening ceremony for the Delta Lloyd Regatta is scheduled to begin 1700 on Monday May 23 at the International Sailing Center Medemblik.

5.4 The warning signal for the first race on Thursday May 26 is scheduled to be no earlier than 1000.

5.5 The prize giving and closing ceremony is scheduled to begin 1700 on Saturday May 28, 2016.

6 FORMAT

The regatta will consist of a single series.

7 COURSES

7.1 The courses will be Upwind-Downwind.

7.2 Courses, starting- and finish systems will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

8 EQUIPMENT & EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

8.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate and all sails intended to be used for inspection during the registration. Random checks of other equipment will be made in the boat park.

9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available Thursday May 19 on the event website. Other documents governing the event will be published with the Sailing Instructions.

10 SCORING

10.1 A low point scoring system will be used.

10.2 The 'Gland Prix' (Lapped Finish) will be used. The SI will describe further details.

12. PENALTY SYSTEM

In the International Moth class, RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11 INTERNATIONAL JURY

An International Jury may be appointed in accordance with the RRS 91(b). Their decisions will be final and cannot be appealed, as specified in RRS 70.5.

12 SUPPORT BOATS

12.1 All support boats shall be registered with the Organising Authority and will be required to comply with local legislation and event support boat regulations. The Organising Authority may refuse registrations and accept later registrations at their sole discretion.

12.2 All support boats shall clearly display the 3 letter national code of their ISAF Member National Authority at all times while afloat. The minimum height for the letters shall be 200 mm and visible on both sides of the boat.

12.3 Support boats with team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the starting sequence until all boats have finished or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.

13 MEDALS AND PRIZES

13.1 Medals or trophies shall be awarded to the first three competitors in each Class / Division depending on entry numbers.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. Neither the Organising Authority will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15 INSURANCE

Each participating boat must hold third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of at least 1.500,000 Euros (or equivalent) per incident.

16 TELEVISION AND MEDIA

16.1 By participating in an event of the EUROSAF European Sailing Cup competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority, EUROSAF and their sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.

- 16.2** Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment and positioning equipment as specified by the Organising Authority.
- 16.3** The top three competitors as well as the individual race winners may be required to attend a media press conference each day.
- 16.4** Competitors may be required for interviews at the regatta.
